

## **UPON ARRIVAL: FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELERS**

*As of January 6, 2022*

### **Do I need to quarantine upon arrival in The Bahamas?**

- No, there are currently no quarantine requirements for those travelling with approved Bahamas Travel Health Visas.

### **Can I travel to every island in The Bahamas?**

- All islands in The Bahamas are open to international and domestic arrivals, including commercial and private aircraft, as well as private yachts and pleasure crafts.
- From time to time, the Government of The Bahamas may restrict travel into or out of certain islands.
  - Travelers should check the status of their island destination before travelling, by visiting [Bahamas.com/travelupdates](https://bahamas.com/travelupdates).

### **I'm fully vaccinated, am I still-required to take a COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test on Day 5 of my stay?**

1. Yes, effective December 27, 2021, All **travelers** who enter The Bahamas and are staying in their destination for longer than four (4) nights and five (5) days will be required to take a rapid COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test.
2. All visitors departing on or before day 5 will not be required to obtain this test.
3. **Effective January 4, 2022, this test will be replaced with a Rapid Antigen Test required for all fully vaccinated travelers staying longer than 48 hours (two (2) nights).**
4. The day of arrival is considered Day 1 of a person's stay.

### **Am I required to complete a daily Health Questionnaire as a vaccinated traveler?**

- No, fully vaccinated travelers are **exempt** from completing the daily Health Questionnaire.
