Summary

- ❖ Nationally, Sentrilock home showings were down 12% year-overyear. Showings declined in every region: Northeast (-10%), Midwest (-23%), West (-16%), and South (-1).
- The number of cards, a measure of the number of REALTORS® showing homes, increased 2% year-over-year.
- Showings per card, a measure of the intensity of demand and buyer competition, decreased 14% yearover-year.

United States

Showings Down 12% Y/Y in January

January 2023 U.S. showings were down 12% year-over-year, with 586,744 showings, according to data from SentriLock, LLC., a lockbox company. The pace of showing activity declined compared to last month, December 2022.


SentriLock Cards Increased 2% Y/Y

Total U.S. SentriLock cards rose 2% year-overyear to 221,285. SentriLock cards, comprised of SentriKey® and SentriCard®, allow REALTORS® to access the Sentrilock® lockbox and is an indicator of the number of REALTORS® who conduct the showing.

Showings Per Card Decreased by 14% Y/Y


The number of showings per card reflects the strength of buyer interest per listed property. At a national level, showings per card decreased 14% year-over-year in January.


U.S. Y/Y Change in Showings Per Card



U.S. Showings Per Card








U.S. Y/Y Change in Cards

Regional

All Four Regions Saw Y/Y Showings Decrease


All four regions saw a decrease in showings on a year-over-year basis in September: Northeast region (-10%), Midwest (-23%), West (-16%), and the South (-1%)

Y/Y SentriLock Cards Increased In Three of the Four Regions

Cards on a y/y basis were up in the South (15%), followed by the Northeast (2). Cards were up in the West (1%) but the Midwest was down (-12%).

Showings Per Card Decreased In All Four Regions On A Y/Y Basis

All regions saw a year-over-year decrease in showings per card in January. The West had the largest dip of (16%) followed by the South with a decline of (-14). The Midwest fell (-13%), and the Northeast had the smallest decline (-12%).






Midwest Region

Midwest Region Showings Decreased 23% Y/Y

The Midwest region showings declined y/y in January. The January 2023 figure represents a decrease of -23% year-over-year. The Midwest totaled 123,593 showings. Midwest Region Sentrilock cards increased to 60,603. Showings per card declined to 2.0. Year-over-year percent change in showings per card decreased by 13%.






Midwest Y/Y Change in Showings






Northeast Region

Northeast Region Showings Decreased 10% Y/Y

The Northeast region showings decreased y/y in January. NE region showings decreased by 10% year-over-year. The Northeast totaled 3,334 showings in January. Northeast Region Sentrilock cards increased to 4,390. Showings per card fell to 1.3. Year-over-year percent change in showings per card decreased by 12%.










Northeast Y/Y Change in Showings









South Region

South Region Showings Decreased 1% Y/Y


Showings in the Southern region decreased in January 2023 by 1% from the same period a year ago. The South totaled 231,958 showings in January. South Region Sentrilock cards increased to 83,412. Showings per card increased to 2.8, equal to the national level. Year-over-year percent change in showings per card declined by 14%.

South Showings Per Card






West Region


West Region Showings Decreased 16% Y/Y

The West region showings decreased y/y in January. Showings decreased by 16% year-over-year. The West totaled 226,803 showings in January. West Region Sentrilock cards increased to 75,904. Showings per card were the same as last month (3.1) and were the highest amongst regions. Y/Y percent change in showings per card was -16%.



Every month SentriLock, LLC. provides NAR with data on the number of properties shown by a REALTOR®. SentriLock Lockboxes are used in roughly a third of home showings across the nation. Foot traffic has a strong correlation with future contracts and home sales, so it can be viewed as a peek ahead at sales trends two to three months into the future.

Showings Definition: a scheduled appointment with a REALTOR® where a potential buyer of a property toured a home.

Card Definition: the number of accesses to SentriLock Lockboxes a REALTOR® inserts their SentriCard® into or uses their SentriKey® to gain access to properties.

Showings Per Card Definition: the average showings per card

SentriCard®:contains authorization data that allows you to access lockbox key compartments,

SentriKey®: lockbox system app that contains authorization data that allows REALTORS® to access lockbox key compartments. Most lockbox accesses are via the SentriKey® smart phone app.

The number of showings reflects the number of properties, viewed, the number of potential buyers viewing the property, and the number of views by a potential I buyer on a property. The increase in showings and cards can also reflect increasing market coverage of Sentrilock.
