## NAR DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD (DSA) IMPORTANT QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR DSA CANDIDATES

## Please read carefully!

## The DSA Council will only consider a nomination that meets the following Criteria:

- 1. Candidates and/or their associations must complete the application in the order in which the information is requested:
  - Local Board / Association
  - State Association
  - National Association
  - Institutes, Societies & Councils
  - Multi-Cultural Real Estate Organizations
  - Additional Information

On the page for each level of the organization (local, state & national), it is important to list <u>first</u> any leadership positions (i.e. Officer or Chair) and awards (i.e. REALTOR® of the Year). Remaining items should be placed in descending order. Be as organized as possible when completing this information. Be sure to review the sample application as an example.

- 2. Candidates must have attained the age of **60** <u>or</u> have at least **25 years** of service with the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS\*, including leadership positions within the Local, State and National level, and the Institutes, Societies and Councils.
- 3. Candidates must have performed in leadership positions at <u>ALL</u> levels of the REALTOR® organization local, state and national associations and <u>remain actively involved.</u>
- 4. Candidates must be a REALTOR® in good standing, currently licensed or certified and **active** in the real estate industry.
- 5. Candidates have been recognized as a local leader whose performance of service and involvement in political and community activities is extraordinary.
- 6. Candidates cannot have served as President of the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS®.
- 7. Letters of endorsement from the candidate's local and state associations are the <u>ONLY</u> endorsements that will be considered by the Council. All other forms of endorsements, written or oral, will not be considered and are not helpful to the candidate.
- 8. Candidates who have invested in RPAC must make sure that this information is **only** listed under "Additional Information" (page 5-6 of the Application). Contributions to RPAC are important; **HOWEVER**, it is not a reason candidates are awarded the DSA.
- 9. A professional headshot of all candidates is required in the form of a high-resolution electronic file. To ensure clarity, the photo should have a minimum resolution of 1200 x 1600. You may e-mail your photo directly to <a href="NARDSA@realtors.org">NARDSA@realtors.org</a>.

Deadline for submission is Friday, April 5, 2024
