## C2EX Ambassador Challenge FAQs:

What is the difference between a Traditional Application and Fast Tracked Application?

- A **traditional application** does not require nomination or approval from a members association. Members will submit 2 letters of recommendation and <u>notify</u> their association that they have applied. This application requires review by the C2EX Program Staff and Committee for approval.
- A Fast Tracked application requires a member of the association leadership (AE, Education Director, etc) to complete a nomination form. If nominated by the association, full committee review is not required and ambassador is approved upon confirmation of complete application.

How long does it take to review a Traditional Application?

• The committee will review the application, make selections based on the applicant's qualifications. This process can take 3-5 weeks depend on volume of applications received and committee availability.

How soon will traditional ambassadors hear about their selection?

• The first batch of traditional applications will be reviewed by Aug. 20, 2024.

How soon will Fast Track Ambassadors hear about their selections

Within 5 business days.

How will ambassadors be trained?

- Asynchronous training will be available to fast-tracked Ambassadors nominated by their Associations. Fast Track Ambassadors must complete a quiz after the training to be officially recognized as ambassadors.
- A live training will be available to ambassadors whose applications were reviewed by the committee and fast-tracked Ambassadors in September

Can an association nominate more than 1 ambassador?

Yes, associations are encouraged to have as many Ambassadors as they see fit!
